- Working with AVERE communications and policy teams to leverage European projects' work to support our policy agenda
- Supporting the organization of AVERE's dissemination role
- Representing AVERE in a variety of stakeholder fora, as well as at external conferences and events

Requirements:

- Passion for the electrification of European Transport
- Proven experience in contributing to projects under Horizon Europe, ideally regarding grids/energy infrastructure, batteries, or decarbonised transport
- A strong academic track record and and/or experience working on drafting studies or research papers in a think tank, NGO, corporate or consultancy environment
- Fluency in English (spoken and written) - knowledge of additional languages is an asset
- Outstanding organizational and leadership skills, taking the lead across all aspects of our project and scientific work
- Strong interpersonal skills - ideally first experience working in membership-based organisations
